Summary of safeguarding concerns raised:

Total safeguarding concerns raised: 3,814

Section 42 enquiries: 839 cases, which is 22% of the total

Other enquiries: 125 cases, which is 3.28% of the total

Risk Outcome

66.9% of risks were reduced

17% of risks were removed

Making Safeguarding Personal

73.2% of individuals were asked about their desired outcomes

Of those asked:

62.9% said their outcomes were achieved

31.59% said their outcomes were partially achieved

5.51% said their outcomes were not achieved
